## Job Description - Production Operative Tumbler Role (Pressworks)

### SUMMARY

As part of Presswork's production team, you will be working mainly in your own area but within a production team. The role involves stages of production to manufacture motorcycle and automotive brake pad components to high standards of quality and efficiency.

This role involves a significant amount of manual handling (standing, walking, lifting, bending, and packing of goods). Care and attention must be taken, not to mix up different references and paperwork. Full training will be provided.

### PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Operate a tumble de-burr vibratory bowl machine and dryer.
- De-burring components using air sanders and finishing machines.
- Moving goods using a pump truck to a different area within production.
- Maintaining the general tidiness of the production area.
- Complete paperwork showing daily production.
- Any other duties as issued by the Pressworks Supervisor.

### KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS

- Previous production, manufacturing or engineering experience preferred.
- Counterbalance Forklift Licence desirable but not essential as in-house training can be provided.
- Self motivated, must have a strong desire to deliver against targets and to a high standard.
- Must be hard working, able to work as part of a team but also independently.
- Ability to work independently in line with standard operating procedures and follow instructions.
- Ability to read, write, communicate, and comprehend written and verbal instructions in English.
- Experience in manual handling.
